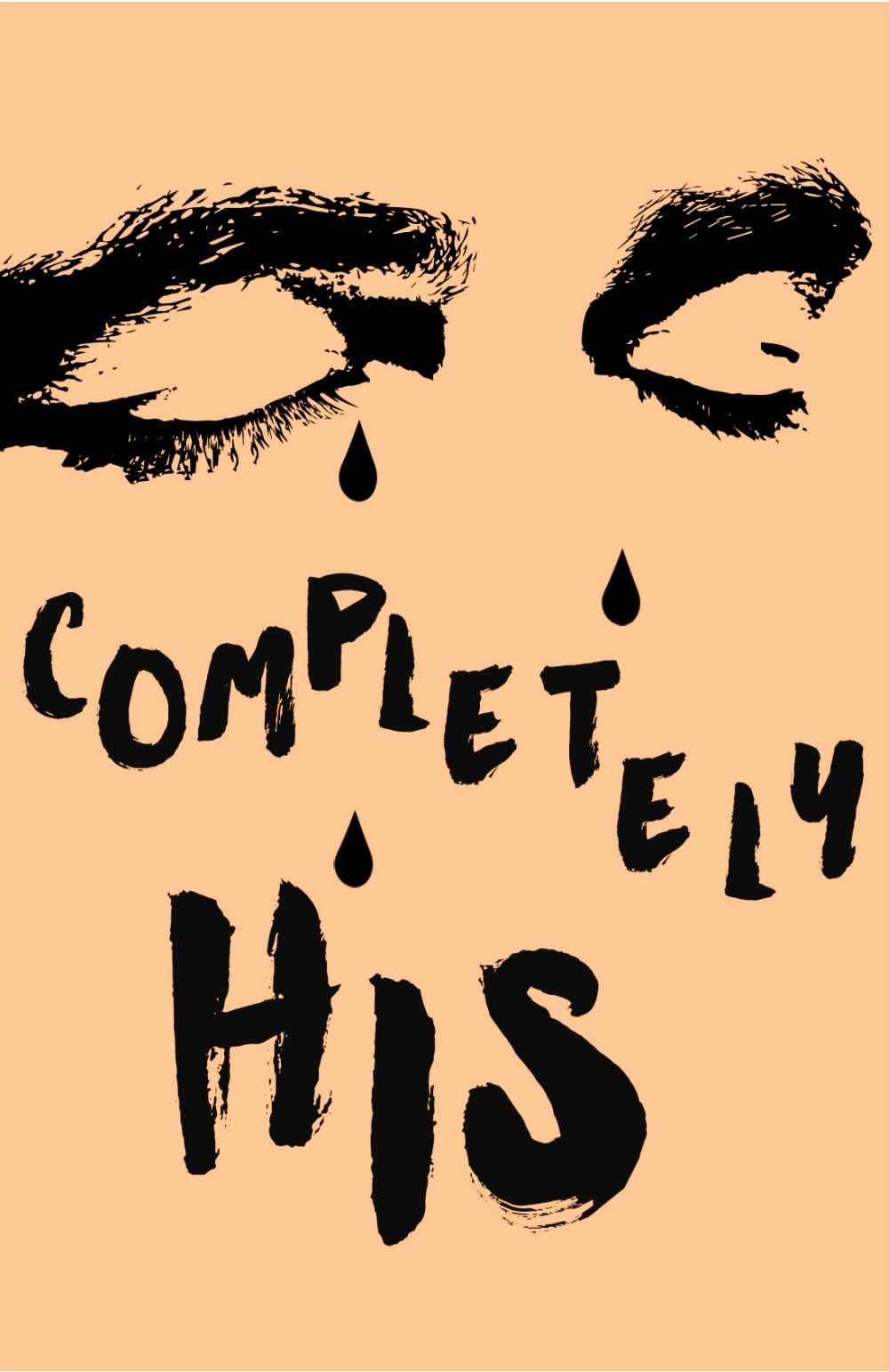

The churches are vibrant and growing, and missionaries are highly motivated and reaching out in bold witness and loving the French people. May the Lord bring peace especially to those who lost loved ones and to those who have recently been traumatized.

**Pray for Suzy Grumelot**, as she serves in Paris with World Team. Suzy was in North Carolina for training during the attacks last week. Thankfully her teammates are 'safe and sound.' Pastor Samuel (church in downtown Paris) asks for prayer for the police and rescue workers who are exhausted. He is the Chaplain for the 800+ firefighters, and many were on duty all night as first-responders. Pray for his ongoing interactions with a hurting community.
