Pray for Compassion Evangelical Hospital in Guinea, West Africa. 2015 ended in praising God for several things: registering its 80,000 patient visit, provision of solar energy, a new laundry, and much needed maintenance and IT improvements! They are praying that God will give them 2 general surgeons and a nurse anesthetist, as the need is great. They are talking to a Christian ophthalmologist to care for general eye needs and perform cataract surgery with lens implants. With one dentist now on staff, they need to expand the clinic to its planned second phase. Later in 2016 they hope to add 1 or 2 more 8-bed wards. They would like to house these professionals on the station to be available for emergencies. Pray with them that the Lord of the Harvest will send forth the laborers He desires, and they will know the steps in which they should walk.
