## MOM'S CARE - *A ministry for moms who raise children alone*

Moms need the opportunity to communicate and feel support from others struggling in the same way. They are often overwhelmed with financial and parenting issues, exhausted and lacking time to feed their own souls with the Word of God and prayer.

**MOM'S CARE** is a community of women who:
